Please Note: New CKC Ruling: Canadian Resident non CKC Members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC.

Dead ducks will be used in this trial. Males and females will be run in order of the draw.

Starting dog in the Open Stakes to be determined by the TSX closing on Thursday, April 12th, 2012

A system of rotation will be used for the start of subsequent series in the All-Age Stakes.

Wingers may be used in all stakes. Female dogs will not be vetted and handlers are reminded that bitches in estrus cannot compete in a CKC Licensed Trial.
