- Ducks or pheasants will be used at all stakes
- Wingers may be used
- Stakes may run into the next day
- Males & females will be run in the order of the draw or at the discretion of the Marshall
- Bitches in season may not compete and must be withdrawn
- Entry listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. **An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the FT Secretary before the start of the stake to qualify for a refund**
- A system of rotation will be used in the Open and Amateur stakes
- Prizes and /or rosettes will be awarded for each placing and will be presented at the conclusion of each stake
- **Unofficial Puppy Stake:** Will be held on Sunday, May 16th, 2009, providing there are 5 or more puppies entered. Please indicate on your entry if you will be running a puppy. Entry fee: \$10.00
- There will be a tailgate dinner Saturday night. Cost: \$10.00 per person. Please indicate on your entry if you will be attending.

Retriever Field Trial Rules & Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club State In:

Section 21.7, Page 68

“It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.”

Section 3.3.2, Page 7

"Judges shall have the authority to disqualify any dog which does not appear within 15 minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tried."

Release and Indemnification

By participating in these trials (as handler, spectator or in any other role) each participant agrees to assume all risk and hazards incidental to these trials and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the British Columbia Labrador Retriever Club (1995) Society and its members, any volunteer and the owners of the property upon which the tests are held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, cost expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.
